We have been reviewing concepts with them as part of the revision week and encouraging them to practice areas that they are not confident about again at home. With these mock tests, we are sure they will gain more confidence as they approach their end of the year examinations.

In view of the warm weather approaching, and as a 'trial' period from Monday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> to Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, we have decided to revise the school timings, and the students will leave 15 minutes earlier their usual departure time every day.

This revision in timing will only impact the 'zero' period dedicated to co-curriculars, and also as part of the trial period, with each grade, we will have multiple activities instead of one to make the zero period more effective and exciting for the students.
