Post our discussion on Friday, February 28th and subsequent minutes of the meeting that were emailed to you, as a team, we have actioned out several strategies and teachers are looking forward to sharing their observations post the mock examinations with students. The rationale for these mock examinations following the revision week is to enable students to share their understanding of the subject content with confidence and ease, and give them a 'checkpoint' assessment prior to the final examinations. They get familiar with the examination format, are aware of their own ability to manage their time when answering, recognise where they are making mistakes and also, some aspects which require further 'brushing' up in case they missed this focus when revising. This preparation, we believe allows children a structured road map and your role as parents is to support them, and motivate them to revise at home. Their queries will be answered by teachers in school, so please let us know in case you face difficulties at home.

Our revised timing for the zero period commenced yesterday and we look forward to your feedback by the end of the week in terms of impact as discussed in the meeting.

We have received your feedback for co-curricular analysis, we thank you for the same.

The English Enrichment strategy shared with you will be implemented but we will prioritise the mock examination. Teachers are ready to execute these ideas and we are confident it will create a strong foundation for the students in time.
