❖ Commentary Time: GRADES 3 and 4

- ❖ Only learners studying in Grade 3 and 4 will participate in the above competition.
- ❖ Participants will be doing a commentary on any muted video (sports/recipe/animal movement) for over 3 minutes.
- ❖ Participant has to choose a video and get it approved by the language teacher of the school.
- ❖ This approved video has to be brought in a properly scanned (free of virus and malware) pen drive
- ❖ Originality will be appreciated.
- ❖ The competition **is open to all three languages**.
- ❖ It is an individual competition. Hence, only single entry per school will be accepted.
- ❖ The time limit is 3 Minutes. Adherence to the time-limit will be appreciated.
- ❖ No participant can point out any individual or religion in any way, and any dual meaning obscene content is strictly not allowed.
- ❖ **Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.**
- ❖ **The decision of the judges will be final and binding.**
- ❖ **Last date of submitting the entry will be 20th September 2022.**

❖ HASGULLO KI BAUCHAR: Pool- 1 - (GRADES 5 and 6)

❖ HASGULLO KI BAUCHAR: Pool- 2 - (GRADES 7 and 8)

- Each school can send entries from Pool 1 and Pool 2. Which means there can only two entries per school.
- Only learners studying in respective grades will participate in the above competition.
- Participants will be presenting a hilarious incident / a poem/scenario/monologue/ within the stipulated time.
- Originality will be appreciated.
- The competition is open only in Marathi and Hindi languages. So the participant can speak either in Hindi or Marathi.
- It is an individual competition.
- The participant has to take approval of their script from their language teachers before performing.
- The time limit is 3 Minutes. 30seconds of buffer time will be allocated. Post this period a bell will ring to indicate the time completion.
- After this buffer time negative marking will be applicable.
- No participant can point out any individual or religion in any way, and any dual meaning obscene content is strictly not allowed.
- **Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.**
- **The decision of the judges will be final and binding.**
- **Last date of submitting the entry will be 20th September 2022.**

❖ SHAKESPEARE GALORE- (GRADES 7 to 10)

- This activity is based on Shakespearean plays.
- It is a group activity in which multiple participants enact anyone of the abridged versions of plays written by Shakespeare.
- It should essentially have a narrator providing setting and story line of the selected play.
- The total performance should not exceed 30 minutes. This includes stage setting, introduction and winding up.

- Props, costumes, background, music, voice-overs and special effects will be appreciated and so should be immensely integrated.
- Name of the Shakespearean play, duration, number of participants are to be mentioned in the entry.
- **Last date of submitting the entry will be 20th September 2022.**

❖ MAIN SAMAY HOON- (GRADES 9 to 10).

- Only learners studying in Grade 9 and 10 will participate in the above competition.
- It should be a thought- provoking contemplation over the topic provided.
- Participant will choose any one topic from the list provided below & prepare a monologue/dialogue with the audience relating with the progression of theme with changing times.
- (For example, if the topic is discrimination, then the participant will express how the issue of discrimination from the time immemorial to the present times).
- Learners can present in any/all the three languages.
- Costumes according to the desired role will be allowed.
- The topic assigned should be well-researched.
- A maximum of 15 minutes will be allocated to each speaker.
- Appropriate props must be used to enhance the act.
- Music & effects will be allowed.
- **Last date of submitting the entry will be 20th September 2022.**
