We will hand over the costumes on 30th November 2023 to all the learners, neatly labelled in a bag.

Plan for Saturday, 2nd December 2023 (Day of the Event):

Attendance & Entry:

- Attendance on the day of the event is compulsory.
- Parents must carry the Annual Cultural Invitation card to attend the program. Please note that the invitation cards are already handed over to the learners.
- For safety reasons, nobody will be permitted to enter without the physical invitation card.

.Arrival & Departure:

All the learners will arrive at the below-mentioned time:

- Learners will depart along with you after the program is over.
- You are requested to be seated half an hour before the start of the programme on the day of the function so that the function can start on time.
- During the programme, we kindly request that you do not approach your ward or the teacher in charge. Your ward's effort deserves undivided attention.
- Also, please do not gather around the stage to click photographs as we have organized a
 professional photographer to capture the moments and this would create a lot of disturbance.
- We shall be sharing the drive link with you to download all the photographs.



Transport:

- We will provide a transport facility ONLY to pick up our learners.
- Please inform in advance if you wish some other parent/guardian to pick up your child. Children
 will NOT be handed over to any other parent without prior written intimation or through an
 official mail.
- Detailed bus routes will be shared soon.

Food:

- The learners should have a proper lunch before reaching the school.
- We will provide light snacks to our learners in school.
- Please ensure that your child carries a labelled water bottle and dry snack for them to munch on during breaks.
- It is recommended to avoid sending chips and packaged unhealthy snacks.
- Chewing gums are prohibited as they may cause trouble if not disposed of properly.
- The school has made arrangements for paid food stalls.

Costume and make-up:

- Learners are requested to come to school wearing their costumes from home. The make-up will be done in school.
- The make-up products used are of the highest quality. However, if your child has any allergy to make-up products, please inform us beforehand.
- Additionally, please ensure that an extra pair of casual clothes is sent with your child, labelled neatly in a bag. This is because the learners will be changing their performance outfits after their performance.
- Ensure that the costume, jewellery and accessories are duly returned. Failing to do so might incur additional costs.

Dispersal:

- For the safety of the children, parents are requested to be patient and follow instructions for the dispersal of students on 2nd December after the event.
- Requesting you to cooperate for the same.

General:

- All the participants must shampoo their hair on the day of the event.
- Please do not accessorize the hair. If any hairstyle is needed, the teacher will inform you
 personally in advance on your personal window.
- All participants should carry a small pouch containing bob-pins, and wet and dry tissues.
- Do not send your child in expensive gold/silver jewellery or watches. The school will **NOT** be responsible for any misplaced items.
