

Sarvankash Vidya Mandir 'No Homework Policy up to Grade II'

As per the CBSE circular dated 21st August, 2018, schools have been asked to implement the instructions about no homework policy up to Grade II

Things to be followed at SVM are:

- No written homework to be given hence activity based and experiential learning based recapitulation might be taken as suggestive for the reinforcement of concepts till Grade 2.
- Class work books will be kept in school.
- Activity books like GK Life, skills and Value education, Art, Craft etc. (if any) will be kept in school and can be shown to parents during PTM.
- In case of long absenteeism, additional books will be sent home on request from parent.

SVM Light School Bag Policy

Role of School:

- Students will be encouraged to arrange their school bags on daily basis as per their time table to
 avoid carrying unnecessary articles, textbooks that are not needed. Authorities may check school
 bags randomly to ensure the proper weight of school bags.
- Each day few subjects' notebooks will be sent home as per the time table for parents' perusal revision which have to be submitted back to the respective subject teachers the very next day.
- Recommended weight of school bag as per the Education Authorities.
